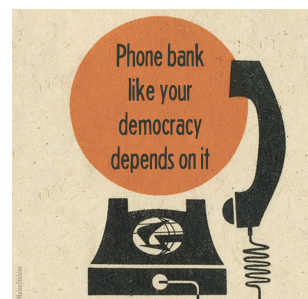

Marin Collegians Teach Digital Skills to Struggling Parents

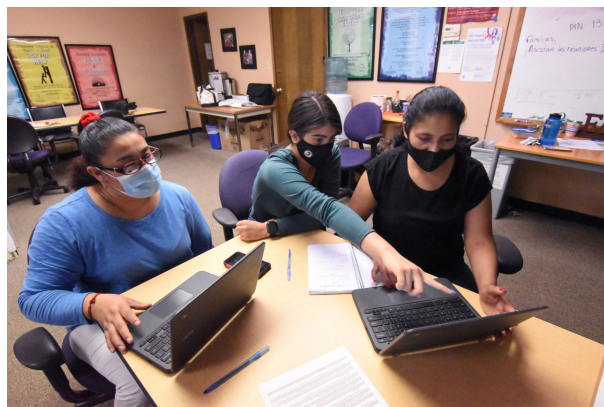
